



## 2023 Suffolk County Police Memorial Fund Off Duty Magazine Scholarship



Entries are now being accepted for the 2023 Suffolk County Police Memorial Fund Off Duty Magazine Scholarship. This scholarship is given as a secondary purpose of the Memorial Fund to encourage education. It is given in memory of those police officers in Suffolk County who have lost their lives while in the performance of their duty.

## Who is eligible:

Any child who is a High School Senior and planning on attending their first year of college or a trade school in September of 2023 and is the son/daughter of active member of the SCPD (as of January 1, 2023) who is a participant in the bi-weekly payroll deduction to the Fund or any active (as of January 1, 2023) sworn member of the Riverhead, Southampton Village, Easthampton Village or Sag Harbor Police Departments. If the member has retired afterJanuary 1, 2023 their children are still eligible.

Five winners and five alternates will be selected at our May meeting or our annual golf outing which is tentatively scheduled for May 2023 at a location to be determined. Winners and alternates need not be present and they will be notified via mail.

Upon proof of entry into the trade school, college or university in September, the Fund will send a one-time payment of \$1,000 to the recipient. Should the winner elect not to attend school in September an alternate will then be selected to replace the original winner. The entry form must be received by May 1, 2023.
